They are killing 85 to 90 percent of the animals that come into Animal Care and Control. Most of that number is kitties. That does not include the kitties that are left to fend for themselves on the streets of PBC. Where they will die from cars, other animals, starvation, disease, or will be poisoned by hateful people, They die horrendous deaths when left to fend for themselves.

The county has done nothing in years to stop the population explosion here in the county. Please write your county commissioners, and let them know how you feel. They need to do FREE spay/neuter or this situation will only get worse. It costs more to kill an animal at ACC than it does to spay/neuter one.

If you come across a cat or kitten that does not have a home please consider keeping it. I will try to help you get the medical care it will need so you can bring it into your home. Cats make wonderful pets, and do get along with other animals, such as dogs, other cats, ferrets. Etc.

Please consider these things that I have just told you, open your heart and home to a homeless animal, you won't be sorry.
